

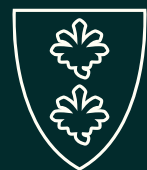

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Drangedal – Forests, Wilderness and Himmelriket

With its countless lakes, beaches, forests and mountains, this area has been an important stopping place and home for people for hundreds of years.

Evidence of settlement dates back to the Viking Age, and historical records tell of thriving trade and welcoming farms as early as the 17th century. For generations, local people have lived in close harmony with nature, and this knowledge has become an integral part of everyday life, culture and identity.

Drangedal is a paradise for anyone seeking authentic nature, tranquillity and history – combined with exciting outdoor activities and adventures right on your doorstep.

In this brochure, we present just a few of the many experiences waiting for you. We hope it inspires you to explore everything from the deep forests and unspoilt wilderness to Himmelriket ("The Kingdom of Heaven"), one of the area's most spectacular natural landmarks.

Drangedal – Prestestranda (Town Centre) and Surroundings

Drangedal is a wonderful year-round destination and a paradise for outdoor enthusiasts. Here you'll find numerous lakes, perfect for swimming, fishing and paddling, as well as endless opportunities for hiking, climbing and mountain biking, with routes for all levels of experience.

Along the shores of Lake Toke, with its 185 kilometres of shoreline and countless islands and sheltered coves, you'll discover one inviting swimming spot after another.

Even in the heart of Drangedal's historic centre, Prestestranda, you'll find a beautiful beach. At Pier Toke Brygge and the traditional boat-houses in the town centre, there is a family-friendly sandy beach with a swimming jetty, playground equipment, a trampoline and a beach volleyball court. The area is fully accessible, making it easy for everyone to enjoy the waterfront.

Kayaks can be rented through Gautefall Turlag (the local trekking association), while canoes are available for hire through Drangedal Municipality. The town centre also offers a selection of shops, cafés and restaurants.

Just south of the town centre, at Neslandsvatn, you'll find a fully accessible walking and cycling path following a historic railway route. The trail is paved and illuminated, making it an enjoyable and atmospheric experience even after dark.

Above all, however, Drangedal is about unforgettable nature experiences. In this brochure you'll find plenty of inspiration for exploring the area.

Drangedal offers a wide range of activities for the whole family. Enjoy miles of peaceful gravel roads, exciting forest trails, smooth granite outcrops perfect for hiking, and scenic country roads with very little traffic. Stay close to nature at dedicated motorhome sites, cosy cabins or comfortable hotels.

Top 3 Cycling Routes

1. Kragerø Railway Trail – Neslandsvatn

A fully accessible walking and cycling trail following the historic route of the former Kragerø Railway, which opened in 1927. The area also features a climbing wall, beach volleyball court, swimming area and a barbecue shelter.

2. The Cultural Heritage Trail

The Cultural Heritage Trail at Drangedalsheia is a well-maintained, family-friendly cycling route that combines beautiful scenery with local history. Along the route you'll discover 15 cultural heritage sites, offering fascinating insights into Drangedal's rich past.

The route starts at Villmarkseventyret Camping.

Distance (return):	15 km
Difficulty:	Easy
Season:	April–October
Duration:	Approximately 1.5 hours
Suitable for:	Families with children and older visitors



3. The Wilderness Trail

Designed for experienced mountain bikers, the Wilderness Trail offers one of Telemark's most challenging cycling adventures.

This purpose-built 23 km circular route is ideal for riders looking for demanding terrain and an exciting wilderness experience. The trail begins at the Åslandsfjell car park.

Difficulty:	Moderate to challenging
Season:	April–November
Duration:	Approximately 3 hours
Suitable for:	Adults

Discover history brought to life

Situated in the beautiful Telemark countryside, close to Lake Motjenn and surrounded by forests, Drangedal Bygdetun is a living heritage site where culture, history and nature come together. Here you may experience authentic rural life in peaceful surroundings where time seems to slow down.

History in harmony with nature

At Drangedal Bygdetun, nature and cultural heritage go hand in hand. Experience traditional timber buildings and historic tools, and discover how people once lived in close harmony with the forest, farmland and lakes.

The museum features 21 buildings, including 19 historic buildings dating from the 18th to the 20th century. Farmhouses, storehouses, barns, outbuildings and workshops illustrate traditional crafts and farming life.

Each building tells its own story of everyday life in rural Norway. Many have been carefully relocated to preserve their original character, offering an authentic glimpse into Norway's rural heritage.

Wilderness on your doorstep

Nature is never far away. Just beyond the museum you'll find peaceful forests and lakes, perfect for simple outdoor experiences. A barbecue shelter and fire pit provide welcoming places to relax and enjoy good company.

Whether you're visiting with family, friends or a group, the area offers easy, nature-based experiences for everyone.

Something for all ages

Drangedal Bygdetun offers something for everyone. Discover traditional crafts, join seasonal events and enjoy family-friendly activities.

Combining history with outdoor experiences, the museum is an ideal destination for families, history enthusiasts and nature lovers.

During the summer, guided tours are available, while concerts, markets and cultural events are held throughout the year.

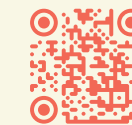

Drangedal – From Forests and Wilderness to Himmelriket

Drangedal and Gautefall are a paradise for hikers, with an extensive network of marked trails. Whether you're looking for an easy walk or a more challenging hike, you'll find routes leading to historic sites and spectacular viewpoints with views stretching towards Kragerø, Bø and Skien.

We recommend every visitor to experience Himmelriket on Gautefall – one of nature's true masterpieces. This remarkable destination features spectacular granite rock formations sculpted by glaciers during the last Ice Age, creating a unique landscape of smooth, polished stone.

The result is a dramatic natural formation resembling a vast Roman amphitheatre. The hike is relatively easy and rewards you with an unforgettable nature experience.

There are trails for all ages and abilities. Family-friendly routes such as the Kragerø Railway Trail and the Adventure Trail offer activities for children, while more adventurous visitors can explore the forests and wilderness or tackle challenging summit hikes such as Rønnonnibben.

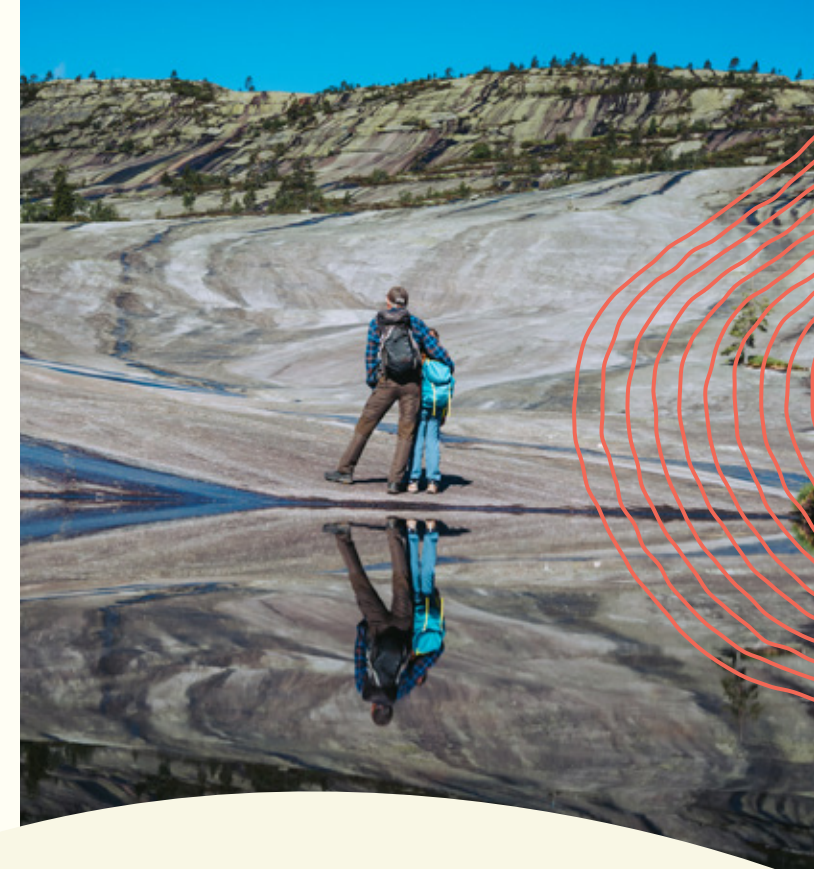
Along the way you'll also discover inviting swimming spots, peaceful fishing lakes, wild blueberries and chanterelle mushrooms. Take your time and enjoy the beauty of nature.

Top 3 hikes

Himmelriket

Visit nature's own amphitheatre, with spectacular smooth granite slabs shaped by the Ice Age – a unique experience for all ages. The trail starts at Gautefall Ski Centre, passing under the road towards the hotel. The marked trail begins between the Red Cross Cabin and the Mountain Church.

Distance (return):	4,5 km
Difficulty:	Easy
Season:	Year-round
Duration:	1 hour
Suitable for:	Children and older visitors



Nåsnibben

At 400 metres above sea level, Nåsnibben is one of the region's finest viewpoints. This moderate hike passes through varied woodland and across open hillsides, making it perfect for anyone wanting to experience Telemark's beautiful scenery.

Distance (return):	5,6 km
Difficulty:	Moderate
Season:	April–October
Duration:	2 hours
Suitable for:	Adults and children with hiking experience

Rønnonnibben

At 615 metres above sea level, Rønnonnibben is Drangedal's most spectacular summit – often described as the region's answer to Trolltunga and Preikestolen. Parking is available along Highway 358 at Åse, midway between Bostrak and Gautefall.

Distance (return):	9,2 km
Difficulty:	Challenging (rope-assisted climbing required on the final section)
Season:	May–October
Duration:	5 hours
Suitable for:	Adults and teenagers

A small modern cabin in the forest, about 1.5 km from the farm and reached by gravel road. There is no electricity or running water – just peace, simplicity and real forest life, overlooking the quiet woodland lake Sauvatjern.

Camping and Hammocks

Sauvatjern is a peaceful woodland lake, while Lake Bjårvann is slightly larger and offers excellent swimming. Pitch a tent or hang your hammock by the water. Canoes and rowing boats are available at both lakes.

- Nature-based physical and mental training: Tailor-made programmes for groups (8–20 people), focusing on fitness, achievement, teamwork and mental resilience.
- Farm Fitness: A unique workout inspired by farm life, using practical outdoor tasks.

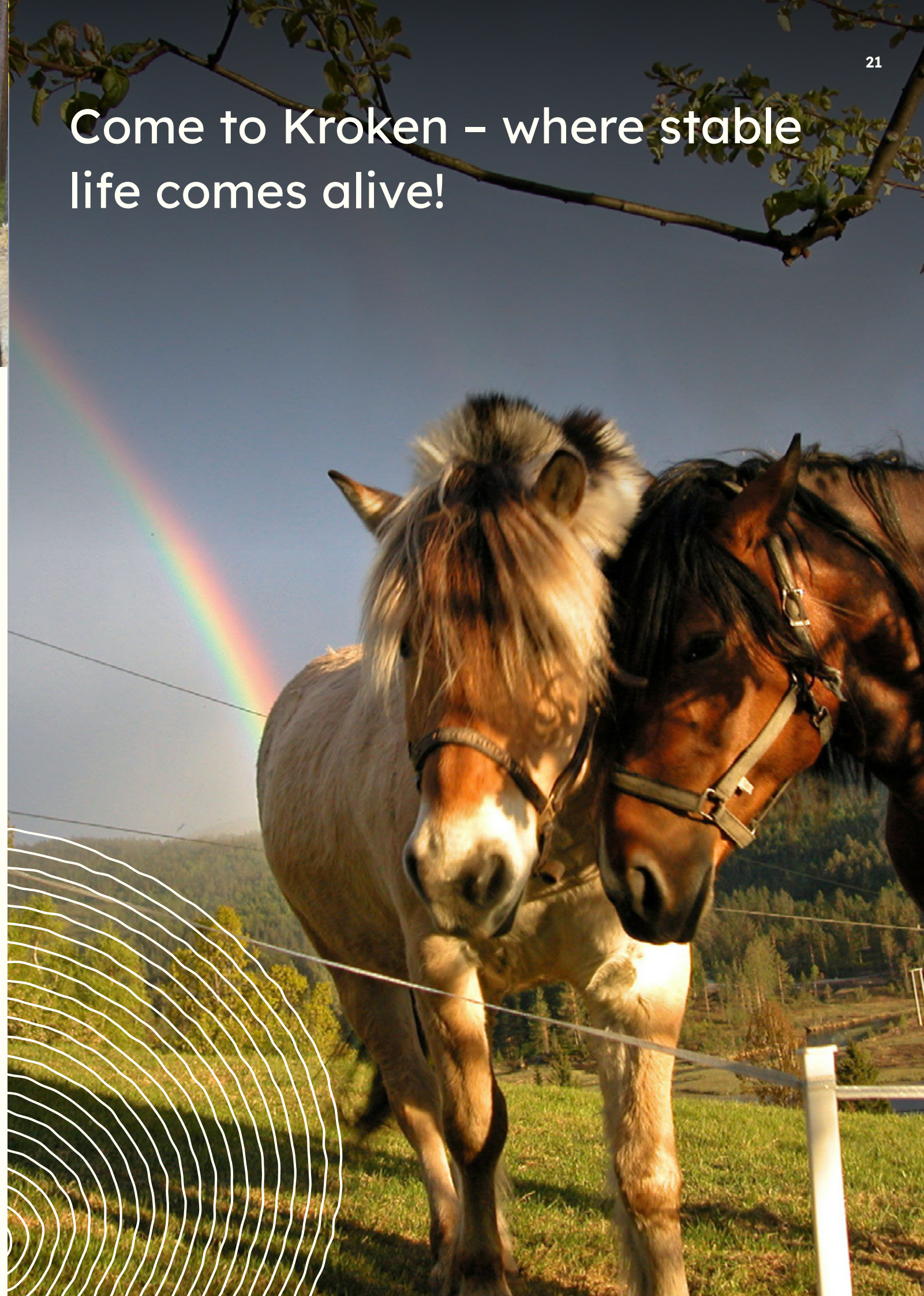

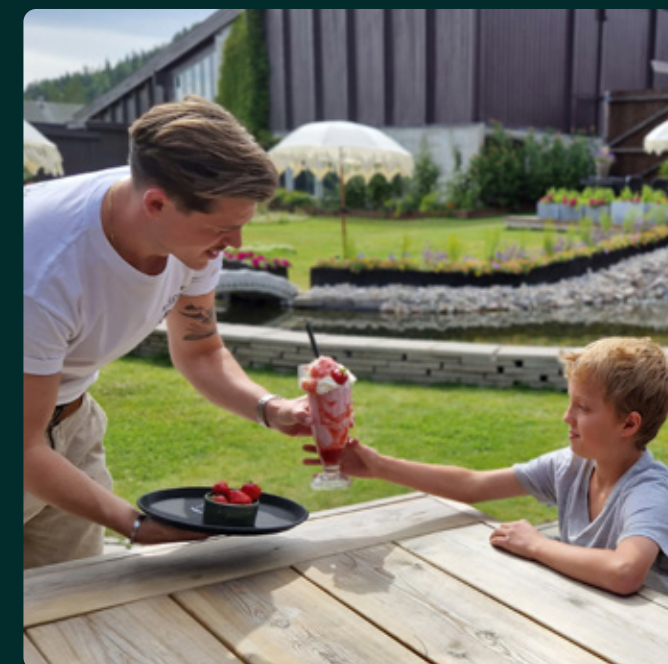

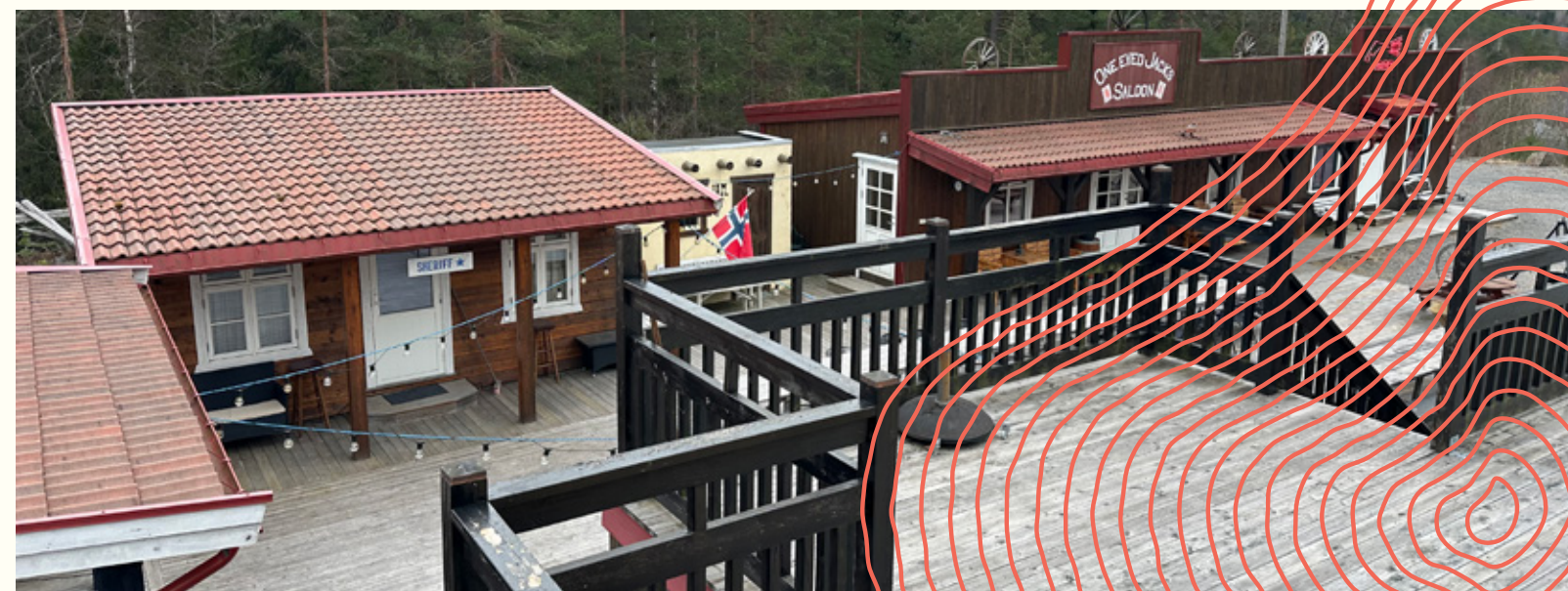

Many people have heard of these places without realising they are all part of Drangedal – an area rich in nature and unforgettable experiences.

One of the region's best-known natural attractions is Himmelriket at Gautefall. According to local legend, a group of travelling surveyors camped here. When they awoke in a vast natural rock basin, shaped like an amphitheatre in the smooth granite, they were so impressed that they named the place Himmelriket – The Kingdom of Heaven.

Today, Himmelriket is a popular destination, reached by a marked hiking trail, the Via Ferrata, or by mountain bike – an experience that truly lives up to its name.
